The i-Ready Assessment tests learners' knowledge against content for the entire grade level. At the time of assessment, students had completed approximately one-half of the material against which they were assessed. Lastly, while not addressed in detail in the report, The Biome has reconstituted many elements of its STEAM projects, most notably with the St. Louis Zoo and working to establish programming with the Magic House in the Maker's District.
